March 26-30, 2020

- 4 nights with breakfast at Table Bay Hotel on the Victoria & Albert Waterfront

- ½ day Table Mountain Tour

Depart US City for Victoria Falls	Tue, 3/17/2020	
Depart from US en route to Victoria Falls on overnight flight.		
Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe	Wed, 3/18/2020	
Arrive at Victoria Falls International Airport in Zimbabwe, the Gateway to Victoria Falls. Welcome to Southern Africa! Upon arrival, transfer to Ilala Lodge for a bit of relaxation following your journey from the US to Zimbabwe. The Ilala Lodge, our home for 2 nights, is ideally situated on the Zimbabwean side of the mighty Zambezi River, where it is the closest hotel to the magnificent Falls. Voted one of the World's Seven Natural Wonders, the Victoria Falls are within easy walking distance for guests, as is the town center. Wild animals, such as warthog and impala, often graze on the hotel lawns and provide exciting entertainment for hotel guests. D.		
Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe	Thu, 3/19/2020	
Victoria Falls Tour. This morning, enjoy a delightful breakfast before heading out on an informative guided tour of Victoria Falls. Victoria Falls constitutes one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the world. The local people call it "Mosi-oa-Tunya" the smoke that thunders and the Falls are remarkable. There is a magic about them manifested in the towering column of spray when the river is high, the thunder of the falling water, the terrifying abyss and tranquil lagoons upstream in which hippo and deadly crocodiles lurk. The Victoria Falls is 1,708 meters wide, making it the largest curtain of water in the world. It drops between 90m and 107m into the Zambezi Gorge and an average of 550,000 cubic meters of water plummet over the edge every minute. Remarkably preserved in its natural state, Victoria Falls inspires visitors as much today as it did David Livingstone in the 1860's. Relax for the balance of the day, or head out on the world's fourth longest river, the Zambezi, for an optional fishing excursion. B, D.

Batoka Gorge Tour. Chobe National Park, Botswana	Sun, 3/22/2020	
For the next 4 days, we will be journey to an area encompassing one of the highest concentrations of wildlife in the world, Chobe National Park. Following our departure from The Elephant Camp, we will travel by road from Zimbabwe to Botswana's famed Chobe National Park, a haven for lions, leopards, rhinos, Cape buffalo, and elephants, as well as giraffes, hyenas, crocodiles, hippos, countless bird species and more. Have your cameras ready as we enjoy an afternoon game drive later today, and a morning and afternoon game drive each day we are in Chobe beginning tomorrow. From today through the next 3 days, you will be on your dream safari while at the well-appointed Chobe Game Lodge, one of the best lodges in the park. In addition to the game drives, optional spa treatments, fishing, and nature walks are available. B, L, D.

Set against the backdrop of Table Mountain, the Cape Town waterfront is a feast for the eyes. Relax for the balance of the day, and join our group for dinner. B, D.		
Cape Town, South Africa	Fri, 3/27/2020	
Table Mountain (weather permitting). This morning, enjoy a delightful breakfast before heading out on a day of touring Table Mountain. The best views of Cape Town are from the Table Mountain Cableway, a unique and 87-year-old method of seeing the wonders of the city. Travel up to the summit of the majestic flat-topped mountain and be astounded by vistas of the Mother City, Robben Island and the Peninsula. The ride is a gentle one, the rotating state-of-the-art cable car taking visitors from the lower station to the top in around 5 minutes. After returning to the hotel, relax for the balance of the day. B		
Cape Town, South Africa	Sat, 3/28/2020	
Robben Island and Jazz Festival Evening One. This morning, enjoy a delicious breakfast at the hotel before visiting Robben Island. The tour starts at the Nelson Mandela Gateway where the ferry is taken to the Island. Upon arrival, we will hear first-hand accounts from former political prisoners about their and Nelson Mandela's time at this maximum security prison where thousands of South Africa's freedom fighters were incarcerated for years. After returning to the hotel in the early afternoon, take a relaxing stroll along the waterfront or through the neighboring shopping mall for some retail therapy, or take a nap in your room before heading out to the Cape Town Jazz Festival, Africa's Grandest Gathering. Our tickets will include not only admission to this awesome 4-stage festival where many of the world's most prominent musicians perform, but will also include access to a private lounge with hors d'oeuvres, and select wines and soft drinks. Return to the waterfront after an exhilarating evening. B.		
Cape Town, South Africa	Sun, 3/29/2020	
Day at Leisure with Optional Winelands, Cape Peninsula, or City Tour during the day or Jazz Festival Evening Two. Today, we are free to take in optional tours to explore Cape Town's famous vineyards, its strikingly beautiful Peninsula along the Indian Ocean, or the city and its neighborhoods with a guide. Another option is to simply relax, on this, our final day in the Mother City. That relaxation may continue on into the evening, or we may enjoy the Cape Town Jazz Festival's second evening. B
